Phases 2 and 3

2018-2020



New Welcome Centre

- Street level interior access to all the facilities
- Pavilion integrated into Mount Royal with green roofs
- Better accessibility for people with reduced mobility



Holy Family Plaza

- New expansive pedestrian area built on the roof of the Welcome Centre
- New monumental structure for the province of Quebec's only carillon
- Addition of 5 bells to the 56 current bells of the Oratory's carillon



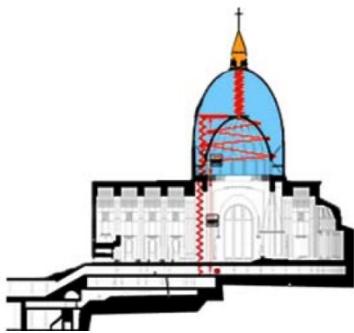
Saint Joseph Garden

- The beautiful garden will create an enchanting setting out front
- Vehicle traffic will be prohibited to make room for more green space
- Increased pedestrian spaces on site

The visitor experience will be enhanced by illumination that will highlight the architectural richness of the shrine.

Phase 4

2020-2022



- **The beautiful, massive dome**
Refurbished to create a large exhibition and interpretation area that visitors can access via a spiral ramp or elevator.
- **The highest view of Montréal**
The observation centre at the top of the dome will offer the city's highest vantage point of Montréal
- **The new Oratory Museum**
Completely refurbished, brighter, multipurpose space that will superbly display its collection of some 30,000 works of art.

Note: Phase 1 of the Major Development Project, including the creation of a new ascent, in addition to the lifts, has been completed in 2009.
